BREEDING FEE IS \$500.00

Mare Owner understands and agrees the mare(s) shall be in healthy breeding condition and that each mare shall have proof of negative coggins, immunizations, including Strangles and West Nile. Proof of a negative uterine culture is required. If you do not have a vet for this service, let me know, and I'll help you make arrangements for a veterinarian in Terrell to perform this service. If any of the above conditions have not been met, mare(s) will not be allowed on the property.

Mares that are not halter broke WILL NOT be accepted: UNLESS, We agree to board your mare for halter training prior to breeding at your expense. This would include a boarding and a training fee.

The mare owner agrees that the stallion owner, Triple M Stables, LLC, Marsha Miller, manager, staff, or any other person, will not be responsible for accidents, sickness, injury, or death to the mares(s) or to any foal. It is also understood that the mare owner will not be responsible for any disease, accident or injury to the stallion. Mare owner agrees to hold Triple M Stables, LLC, Marsha Miller personally, A Walking Horse Ranch, etc. harmless for any and all damages associated herewith.

Mare owner understands and agrees that should the stallion die or become unfit for breeding as determined by a licensed veterinarian, this contract becomes null and void. Absolutely, no refunds, under any circumstances.

Mare owner agrees that if the breeding fee is not paid in full and/or the balance of all mare care fees and expenses, the stallion owner reserves a right to assert a breeder's lien. All costs incurred in collecting delinquent charges shall be the responsibility of the mare owner. These costs are including, but not limited to the following: court costs, attorney's fees, ship tracing, etc.

The stallion owner guarantees a live foal from the breeding contract: Live foal as defined as a foal that stands and nurses. Should the mare prove not to be in foal, aborts her foal, or the foal is stillborn, the mare owner shall notify the

stallion owner within 7 days of foaling or the date the mare is approved not to be in foal or loses her foal. A written statement from a licensed veterinarian

Verifying that the mare has slipped or produced a nonviable foal must be sent to the stallion owner. This guarantee means the stallion owner shall give the mare owner a free season to the stallion the following year only, subject to the stallion being alive, able to breed, and is still owned by the stallion owner. The mare owner will be subject to mare care and any expenses for any rebreeding. Mare owner understands and agrees that there are no stud fee refunds under any circumstances. Should the stallion you have contracted with, becomes unfit, for service, or sold prior to your mare's conception, but after payment of the breeding fee, the breeding fee may be applied to another stallion at Triple M Stables, LLC.

In the event the mare aborts, the mare owner shall certify to the stallion owner that the mare was accurately and properly administered vaccines to prevent the mare from aborting: Such as booster rhinopneumonitis vaccinations administered as indicated by the individual drug manufacturer.

Mare owner acknowledges that the breeder **STRONGLY** recommends pregnancy checks via ultra-sound at 17 days, and by palpation at 45-60 days. Breeder strongly recommends **RHINO** vaccinations at 5-7-9- months, plus normal vaccinations appropriate for the mare's locale.

Insurance of the mare is strongly suggested.

The breeder will not be held responsible for any mare not conceiving or aborting during pregnancy.

This contract may be assignable and transferable upon approval from stallion owner.

COLOR GUARANTEE: Stallion owner guarantees a color foal. If the foal from this breeding is not of color (i.e. cremello, perlino, palomino, champagne, smoky cream, buckskin, or a combination of white with any of the above), than the contract mare, or substitute mare may be booked the following year at no additional stud fee. All other fees associated with the breeding of the mare, boarding, handling, shipping, collection, veterinarian fees, etc are the responsibility of the mare owner.

Smoky black foal guarantee: If your mare produces a smoky black foal, you have the following options: ((1)) **FULL REFUND** of the stud fee only and a **FREE REBREED** to the mare of your choice **IN EXCHANGE** for the smoky black foal at weaning to Triple M Stables, LLC. Rebreed is available up to one year from the date of the birth of the foal. All other fees, veterinarian,

collection, shipping, handling, mare care, boarding, ect. Is the responsibility of the mare owner?

((OR))

Mare owner keeps the smoky black foal and still receives a FREE REBREED only, allowed up to one year from the date of birth of the foal. Again, all other fees, vetermanarian, collection, handling, shipping, mare care, boarding, etc are the responsibility of the mare owner.

Owners of unregistered mares pay the same stud fee of \$500.00.

To get multiple mare discounts, all contracts must be signed and stud fees paid concurrently, to get reduced stud fees.

SUMMARY OF FEES: Stud fees paid and NOT used can not be applied to other expenses. Foal's registration will not be furnished until the mare's owner's account is in good standing.

Stud Fee-----\$500.00

Pasture board-----Mare only, \$ 10.00 a day
Mare and foal, \$ 14.00 a day

Handling fee-----A \$50 one time charge paid to handlers to breed mare

Transportation fee----- \$50 fee to transport mare to vet for US to verify pg/or
Client pays vet farm call: whichever is applicable.

Your Check Off List Of Things To Do:

____ Take mare(s) to your vet to get current immunizations including, but not limited to West Nile, Coggins, Strangles and a report showing a negative uterine culture, thirty days prior to bringing your mare to the ranch. If your vet does not culture, we can help you with that. We recommend Rabies and Tetanus also.

____ Mail your signed contract, copy of mare'(s) registration papers front and back, immunizations records, and coggins with a check for the stud fee to:

____ Call to get help with scheduling an appt with the Terrell vet, prior to dropping your mare off at Triple M Stables, LLC, for a uterine culture, if your vet does not do the procedure.
